Telefónica O2 Czech Republic, a.s., (Telefónica O2 Czech Republic) was formed on 1st July 2006 by the merger of ČESKÝ TELECOM, a.s. and Eurotel Praha, spol. s r.o. The integration of both companies has given rise to one sole telecommunications company built on the convergence of fixed and mobile services. Telefónica O2 Czech Republic is a telecommunications operator providing a comprehensive offer of voice and data, and internet services through fixed and mobile technologies, including offers to use the network infrastructure for operators and providers of public and private networks and services.

This internship is ideal for someone who is highly motivated, interested in market research and enjoys working with a team on project work. Liberální Institut focuses on three types of activities: **education, research, and publication**. The LI staff organizes four educational events and two essay contests every year, conducts applied research in five broad areas, and has published more than 70 books since 1990.
